Note: Your hunt tag must be visible at all times! Only paid hunters are allowed to be on the hunt fields during seeded hunts.

### **Thursday, April 13:**

Noon - RV campers can begin setup in the park. Sites must 5:00 pm be booked directly through First Monday.

NOTE: NOTE: NO METAL DETECTING IS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY ON THURSDAY. CHECK-IN ONLY.

Friday, April 14:

Overnight tent campers can begin arrival, setup.

Check-in begins at 10am. Pick up your registration package (which includes your hunt tag) at the Civic Center building. After 6pm. pick up your packet

11 am Welcome message; Garrett stage in Civic Center

Hunting FREE RANGE hunting opens at Noon for anyone wearing a hunt tag, but is strictly limited to areas on map

supplied at check-in. Cannon fire will start and end hunt.

7:00 pm - **NOT QUITE NIGHT HUNT\*.** Details to be announced. (*Prize tokens from this hunt to be redeemed Saturday*)

### Saturday, April 15:

7:00 am Main gates open. Continue to pick up registration packs and hunt tags in Civic Center building.

7:30 am **FREE RANGE** hunting in park begins. See map in your hunt pack for any areas that are off-limits.

8:00 am Pre-hunt talks in the Civic Center. Activities for the day are explained. Location of the Relic & Coin Hunt site is revealed. All hunters need to attend.

8:45 am - RELIC & COIN HUNT\*. Civil War relics (minie balls, 11:45 am musketballs, buttons, etc.), non-silver historic coins and prize tokens to dig. Hand diggers or small shovels only. (Location will be revealed Saturday morning at 8am.)

9:30 am Turn-ins begin in Civic Center for cash and prize tokens.

11:30 am - Lunch available via food trucks at the Civic Center. 1:30 pm

12:00 pm - Garrett talk and Jase Robertson presentation on main 1:00 pm stage in the Civic Center.

2:00 pm - KIDS HUNT\*. Limited to kids ages 12 and under. 2:45 pm Location near log cabin in First Monday park. See map

3:00pm - Kids Hunt prize token redemption begins at Civic Center.

4:00 pm - SILVER HUNT\*. Search for silver coins and prize tokens on the same property used for the morning's Relic & Coin Hunt. (Chance to find remnant items and tokens from the morning hunt.)

5:00 pm 7:30 pm
Silver token prizes awarded at Civic Center. All tokens
found for both Relic & Coin Hunt and Silver Hunt must be
turned in by 7:30 pm. After 7:30 pm, drawings will be held
for any unclaimed token prizes.

7:30 pm End of hunting in all Free Range areas.

7:45 pm Unclaimed token drawings. Must be present to win.

## Sunday, April 16:

#### No Garrett activities.

Free Range fun hunting is allowed within permitted areas until 3pm but no token redemption on Sunday.
